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Post-Operative Instructions for Middle Ear Exploration or Tympanoplasty

PROCEDURE:

The patient has undergone middle ear surgery. Depending on the type of surgery and patient's own constitution, the recovery will vary

INSTRUCTIONS FOR HOME:

Expectations: If further bleeding is noted on the dressing after you leave the hospital- call us. Any dizziness or recurrent vomiting is not normal-call us immediately.

F) or increased pain, call us immediately

Drainage from the wound behind the ear or passing of small bits of packing may persist for up to six (6) weeks after surgery

Diet:

On the night of surgery limit the patient to a light diet to help prevent vomiting after the surgery. The patient does <u>not</u> need to eat or drink until the next day. <u>If</u> <u>desired, soups, Jell-O, juices, and popsicles are allowed.</u> No heavy foods, including milk, should be eaten on the evening of surgery. <u>On the day after surgery, the patient may eat anything he or she wants, as long as the stomach had settled.</u>

Some children after adenoidectomy will refuse to eat or drink. If this is severe enough, the child could become dehydrated. Signs of dehydration are: a low grade temperature, dark "straw" colored urine, little or no urine output, dry cracked lips, sunken eyes, and absence of tears when crying.

Call our office if your child experiences these symptoms and you are concerned.

Activity:

- The patient may return to most activities, including school, as desired by your surgeon
- No physical education class, competitive sports, or swimming until cleared by your surgeon
- No heavy lifting or straining

• Limit nose blowing

Ear Care:

- Take care of the bandage as directed by the surgeon
- No hair washing until instructed by surgeon

Medications: Take antibiotics as prescribed

Tylenol is the most adequate for pain relief

DO NOT USE ASPIRIN OR IBUPROFIN PRODUCTS SUCH AS ASPERGUN, ALEVE, MOTRIN, OR ADVIL AS THEY CAN CONTRIBUTE TO BLEEDING. AVOID SUCH HERBALS AS GINSENG, GINGKO, OR GARLIC SUPPLEMENTS

Follow-Up: Surgeon will give you post-operative instructions for follow-up
